I James Chaisson a former employee of Texas Gamma Ray was conducting various jobs in the state of Wyoming 2009 & 2010 time frame. This letter is in Response to Report # 4-2011-034 by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. I did have a LLEA with the local Police for my home address at 1804 Elk St #65 Rock Springs, WY 82901. At the start of the year of 2009 TGR leased a shop at 1535 Elk St. in Rock Springs to show the clients that we were working for that they were planning to stay for the long haul. I can not recall the exact date but I think it was around Oct. of 2009 when the Corporate RSO (Robert Denton) flew to Rock Springs, WY from Pasadena Tx to get the 1535 Elk St. location acceptable for operation. TGR hired a local Alarm Company to install the alarm & camera system along with the back up cell phone system also. It took 2 or 3 days to get the system installed by (Alpine Alarms) out of Green River, WY. Once it was tested & approved by Mr. Denton, myself & Mr. Denton went to the local Police to inform them of the plan to begin storing Radioactive Material at the 1535 Elk St. TGR shop, after the site was approved by the N.R.C. but until the it would continue to be stored at my home address of 1804 Elk St. #65, which we had a LLEA in place already with them. When the Christmas vacation was nearing for 2009 I called the Manager of Pasadena, Tx (Steve Stein) & told him I was renting a SUV to bring myself & my assistant & three children to Louisiana for a visit.

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I told him I was going to park the truck at the shop at 1535 Elk St & asked what was I to do with the camera? Mr Stein told me that Mr Denton was in Canada duck hunting but that he knew that Mr Denton had sent the letter to the NRC requesting for a Inspection for the 1535 Elk St. Office, but he would make a call and get back to me. The following morning Mr Stein told me he checked on my question & that it was OK to put the camera in the Vault & Alarm the Office until I returned from Christmas Vacation. When I returned from Louisiana I returned to work but for the most part continued to keep the camera in the truck at my home 1804 Elk St. #65, on some occasions I stored it at the TGR vault when I knew I had the weekend off. In May of 2010 on the 12th my transmission & transfer case went out & my truck was put in the shop for Repair & TGR rented me a car until the truck was fixed. I was again told by Mr Stein & also Mr Denton to store the camera at the 1535 Elk St. TGR Office & set the Alarm until my truck was fixed. Well it took to the end of May for my truck to be repaired at which my client told me he would no longer use TGR due to the Reason of TGR not getting a Replacement truck for almost 3 weeks. Apparently during the time my truck was being fixed the NRC went by the 1535 Elk St TGR Office & walked about the property but didn't think any Radioactive Material

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was being kept there because they didn't get any readings on their Geiger Counter. When I informed TGR of my clients decision not to use them any longer & that I was going to go to work for the Company they were going to use they tried filing charges on me with the Police & saying I stored a camera at the 1535 Elk St. Office against orders. I went to the Police Station & discussed the matter with the Detective's & No Charges were Filed.

My point is this. #1 TGR & Mr Stien knew I was going to Louisiana for the 2009 Christmas Vacation & knew I was driving with my children. If I wasn't allowed to store the camera at the 1535 Elk St. TGR Office why wasn't I sent a shipping container & papers to send it to Pasadena, ~~TX~~ while I was away? The same stands to reason for when my truck was being fixed in May of 2010, I had no shipping barrels or the ability to print the proper forms to ship a source. Through my employment with TGR every time I received a new replacement source I would be sent a source exchanger & the necessary forms to return the old source! I never had a TGR Credit Card except a Gas Card! All I done was follow orders by my Manager & RSD, so if I wasn't allowed to keep the camera at the 1535 Elk St location why was the necessary shipping items sent to me to send it to Pasadena?

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Seems to reason that I was following as I was instructed by my Manager & RSD told me too! Not to mention that the RSD (Mr Denton) was the one who brought & hired & instructed the Alarm Company of how & where to place the sensors & cameras & keypads for the TGR 1535 Elk St location! Which should prove that I wasn't the Wyoming RSD for TGR, because if I would have been I would have had the work done myself. Not to mention I have since the leaving employment of May 2010 have worked for TGR on two different occasions one in Vernal, Ut & the most recent in south Texas which just ended on 3-15-12 & the Vernal was from 6-3-11 to 9-7-11. So if I as you guys or saying Deliberately Tried to cause TGR problems why have I been employed by them on two different occasions? When Mr Denton & Mr Stein are Not? As I'm stating I did not have the equipment needed to ship the source back on either occasion & if I was told to do so why wasn't I terminated from employment? I don't have the money to pay some one like McLaurie McGowan everytime I need some one to explain my failure to comply with NRC Regulations, like TGR has had to do numerous times!! Seems to me I only done what I was told to do!!!
