Long call with Mr. Chaisson. After explaining to him several times that ADR essentially requires him to admit he deliberately did what the Order said he did and that it is only the penalty that is negotiated, he decided he wants to go in front of the administrative law judge and challenge the Order itself. He indicated that he doesn't want "this" on his record. As he has repeatedly told us, he again stated that he did not do anything wrong but only did what his company told him to do. He stated he will not admit to doing something deliberately when he doesn't believe he did anything other than what he was told.

Ray will be contacting headquarters to get someone in touch with Mr. Chaisson who can clearly and simply explain what steps he must complete to get his hearing.
