Thank you for proposing your issue for review. The proposed generic issue (GI) relating to trapped hydrogen and oxygen fire and explosion during fluid transients, which you recently submitted to the GI Program, has been received. This proposed issue, designated as PRE-GI-015, will proceed to the next stage of the review process, and has been entered into the Generic Issues Management Control System for tracking purposes.

The GI Program staff will perform an initial review in accordance with NRC Management Directive and Handbook 6.4, "Generic Issues Program." There are seven specific criteria outlined, none of which can result in a negative response if the proposed issue is to be accepted as a GI in the program. The purpose of an initial review is to provide an evaluation as to whether the proposal clearly meets the generic issue criteria.
