Dear Mr. Wieboldt:

This refers to your application dated August 28, 2014, for renewal of your NRC license. Enclosed with this letter is the renewed license. Pursuant to your e-mail messages dated October 20, and 22, 2014, the renewed license does not include any change in the name of licensed entity and/or the authorized models of portable gauges. The renewed license is written in accordance with current NRC policy and includes revisions of a few conditions of the license.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

The NRC expects licensees to conduct their programs with meticulous attention to detail and high standards of safety and compliance. Serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, and the conditions of the license. You are required to request and receive an amendment to your license *prior* to:

- 1. Changing/adding authorized locations of storage of licensed material;
- 2. Changing the Radiation Safety Officer named on the license;
- 3. Changing the name or ownership of the licensed entity;
- 4. Acquiring licensed material in excess of the maximum possession limits specified on the license or acquiring devices not authorized on the license;

The NRC will continue to periodically inspect your licensed activities. Failure to conduct your program safely and in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and the representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of

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violation, imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
