SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF OCTOBER 30, 2014, PUBLIC MEETING WITH

DOMINION VIRGINIA POWER TO DISCUSS NORTH ANNA

COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION REQUESTS FOR ADDITIONAL

INFORMATION AND OTHER EMERGENT TOPICS

On October 30, 2014, a Category 1 public conference call was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and Dominion Virginia Power (Dominion) regarding the North Anna Unit 3 Combined Operating License Application (COLA). The meeting notice was issued on October 17, 2014, and was available through both the NRC public meeting website and the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) under ADAMS Accession Number ML14290A587. The list of meeting attendees is included as an enclosure.

On December 18, 2013, Dominion submitted a revised COLA that incorporated by reference the General Electric-Hitachi Economic Simplified Boiling Water Reactor, Revision 9 that included all necessary information for the staff to conduct its review. The staff issued a review schedule for the revised COLA on April 7, 2014 (ML14079A174). The topics for discussion during this conference call were the applicant's plan to submit a revised response to North Anna 3 Request for Additional Information 3.5.1.4-2 regarding extreme wind generated missiles, to follow up the October 2, 214, public meeting discussion of toxic gas analysis (ML14281A592).

The meeting commenced at 2:30 p.m. with opening remarks, an introduction of attendees, an announcement of meeting logistics then the discussion of extreme wind generated missiles. A Dominion representative offered that Dominion would pursue a departure from the Economic Simplified Boiling-Water Reactor (ESBWR) design due to North Anna site specific wind conditions not being bounded by the ESBWR design. He then described in detail what parts of the combined license application would be revised to reflect this departure. Following the missile discussion, the toxic gas analysis discussion began.

The staff first discussed its concern that the meteorological conditions Dominion considered when analyzing a gasoline spill were not worst case conditions for the site. Dominion provided some details as to why the specific conditions were used, but the discussion did not provide closure on the issue. As with the October 2, 2014, public meeting, the staff has chosen to deliberate so it may consider the applicant's approach before deciding how to move forward with the safety evaluation.

Following the technical discussion, the public was queried for related comments or questions. One member of the public asked why meteorological conditions considered by the applicant were recorded from the general power plant region but not from within the power plant property.

The meeting was then adjourned at 3:40 p.m.
