SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 17-27437-01

By letter dated August 21, 2014, Mr. Phillip G. Simpkin informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that Baker Hughes Oilfield Operations wished to terminate NRC radioactive materials license 17-27437-01 and combine this license into the existing NRC radioactive materials license 42-02964-01 also issued to Baker Hughes Oilfield Operations. The NRC staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material and locations of use identified in NRC license number 17-27437-01 can be combined into NRC license number 42-02964-01.

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 13 to License No. 17-27437-01 authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14)(xi). Please note that NRC license number 42-02964-01 has been amended accordingly under a separate licensing action.
