Enclosed with the license renewal application dated June 9, 2014 was a letter dated March 4, 2014, requesting NRC's consent for a direct license transfer of NRC Materials License No. 47-21163-01. Please note that the March 4, 2014 letter was sent to an incorrect address for the NRC Region II office and therefore, was never received by the Region I office. In the future, ensure that all correspondence is sent to the Region I office at 2100 Renaissance Boulevard, Suite 100, King of Prussia, PA 19406-2713.

Upon review of the March 4, 2014 letter, we understand that Potomac Valley Hospital has been sold to West Virginia University Hospitals, Inc. The transaction is a result of a planned sale between Harold A McBee, Sr., the owner of all the shares of capital stock of the Potomac Valley Hospital. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any change to the licensee's name, licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use of licensed material, or persons responsible for the licensee's radiation safety program.

Based on the above understandings, and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report, which documents the NRC staff's safety review of the request, the NRC consents to the direct transfer of control. We understand that the sale was finalized on March 1, 2014. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license.

Review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
