**Public Meeting with Industry on the Significance Determination Process**

On February 26, 2015, the staff held a public meeting with industry representatives and discussed the technical basis for the Significance Determination Process (SDP) and the appropriate process to model the safety significance of inspection findings that cause an initiating event occurrence. During the meeting, industry representatives proposed revisions to several SDP guidance documents. The staff asked clarifying questions and plans to revise applicable SDP guidance documents over the next several months after incorporating feedback from all stakeholders.
