The first item is on *Omaha Public Power District* (Fort Calhoun Station, Unit 1), The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order responding to a hearing request by the Sierra Club on license amendments it claims are, or will be, required in the Fort Calhoun Station.

The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order, which denies the hearing request and refers the matters raised in it to the Executive Director for Operations for consideration under 10 C.F.R. § 2.206. Would you please affirm your votes?

CHAIRMAN BURNS: Aye COMMISSIONER SVINICKI: Aye. COMMISSIONER OSTENDORFF: Aye. COMMISSIONER BARAN: Aye.

ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: The second item is on *Entergy Nuclear Operations*, (Indian Point Nuclear Generating Units 2 and 3),

The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order addressing petitions for review of two contentions resolved in Licensing Board Panel-13-13, New York State Contention NYS-8, aging management review of transformers and Hudson River Sloop Clearwater's Contention CW-EC-3A, Environmental Justice. The Commission has voted to approve a memorandum and order which reverses the Board's decision with respect to Contention NYS-8, and affirms in part, and reverses in part, its decision with respect to Contention CW-EC-3A. Chairman Burns did not participate in this matter. Would Commissioners Svinicki, Ostendorff, and Baran please affirm your votes?
