SUBJECT: RESULTS OF PERIODIC REVIEW OF REGULATORY GUIDES  
(RG) 5.7

This memorandum documents the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) periodic review of regulatory guide (RG) 5.7, "Entry/Exit Control for Protected Areas, Vital Areas, and Material Access Areas." RG 5.7 describes measures the NRC staff considers acceptable for implementing entry/exit control requirements at facilities subject to the above regulatory requirements. As discussed in Management Directive 6.6, "Regulatory Guides," the NRC staff reviews RGs approximately every 5 years to ensure that the RGs continue to provide useful guidance. Documentation of the NRC staff review is enclosed.

Based on the results of the periodic review, the staff concludes that a revision to RG 5.7 is not warranted at this time.
