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Office of Administration (ADM) Items of Interest Week Ending April 24, 2015

List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks: Holtec International HI-STORM 100 Cask System, Certificate of Compliance No. 1014, Amendment No. 8, Revision No. 1: Direct Final Rule; Withdrawal; Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 72 (Regulation Identifier Number (RIN) 3150-AJ47; NRC-2014-0233)

On April 20, 2015, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 21639) withdrawing a direct final rule published in the *Federal Register* on February 5, 2015 (80 FR 6430). The direct final rule would have amended the NRC's spent fuel storage regulations by revising the Holtec International HI-STORM 100 Cask System listing within the "List of approved spent fuel storage casks," to add Amendment No. 8, Revision No. 1, to Certificate of Compliance No. 1014. The NRC took this action because it received at least one significant adverse comment in response to the companion proposed rule published in the *Federal Register* on February 5, 2015 (80 FR 6466). The withdrawal of this direct final rule became effective on April 20, 2015.

Alternate Risk-Informed Approach for Addressing the Effects of Debris on Post-Accident Long-Term Core Cooling: Draft Regulatory Guide; Request for Comment; Title 10 CFR, Parts 50 and 52 (RIN 3150-AH42; NRC-2015-0095)

On April 20, 2015, the NRC issued for public comment in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 21658), Draft Regulatory Guide (DG) DG-1322, "Alternate Risk-Informed Approach for Addressing the Effects of Debris on Post-Accident Long-Term Core Cooling." This DG proposes new guidance that describes methods and procedures that the NRC staff considers acceptable for complying with a voluntary, risk-informed alternative in a proposed revision of the NRC's regulations governing the design of emergency core cooling systems. Comments are due by July 6, 2015.

Enterprise-wide Onsite Clerical, Secretarial, and Administrative Support Services

On April 21, 2015, as a result of a non-competitive 8(a) set-aside procurement, indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity, enterprise-wide contract number NRC-HQ-40-15-E-0002 was awarded to Navar, Incorporated, of Manassas, Virginia. The contract provides for onsite clerical, secretarial, and administrative support services for headquarters and regional offices, including the Technical Training Center. The period of performance is from April 22, 2015, through April 21, 2016, with four 1-year option periods. The total estimated price ceiling is \$20,000,000, inclusive of the options.

Enhanced Security of Special Nuclear Material: Regulatory Basis; Title 10 CFR, Part 73; (RIN 3150-AJ41; NRC-2014-0118)

On April 23, 2015, the NRC published a regulatory basis document in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 22434) that supports a proposed rulemaking that would potentially amend the NRC's regulations concerning the security of special nuclear material. The NRC is not seeking public comment at this time.
