Regal Gadolinia-Uranium Low Burnup Spent Nuclear Fuel Assay Data

On June 17, 2015, as a result of a non-competitive solicitation, cost-reimbursement task order number NRC-HQ-60-15-T-0011 was issued under interagency agreement number NRC-HQ-60-14-D-0005 to Oak Ridge National Laboratories, in Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The objective of the task order is to obtain isotopic radio-assay measurements of key nuclides for boiling water reactor burnup credit, especially at peak reactivity and low burnup reactor core exposures. The period of performance is from June 17, 2015, through February 1, 2019. The total cost ceiling is \$612,000.

<u>Linear No-Threshold Model and Standards for Protection Against Radiation: Petition for Rulemaking; Notice of Docketing and Request for Comment; Part 20 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) (NRC-2015-0057)</u>

On June 23, 2015, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) published a notice of docketing and request for comment in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 35870) for three Petitions for Rulemakings (PRM) filed by Carol S. Marcus, Mark L. Miller, and Mohan Doss (the petitioners). The petitioners requests that the NRC amend its "Standards for Protection Against Radiation" regulations and change the basis of those regulations from the "linear no-threshold" model of radiation protection to the "radiation hormesis" model. These petitions were docketed and have been assigned Docket Numbers PRM-20-28, PRM-20-29, and PRM-20-30, respectively. Public comments are due by September 8, 2015.

On June 23, 2015, the NRC published a direct final rule in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 35829), amending its spent fuel storage regulations by revising the Holtec International, Inc., HI-STORM UMAX Canister Storage System listing within the "list of approved spent fuel storage casks" to add Amendment No. 1 to Certificate of Compliance No. 1040. The companion proposed rule was also published in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 35872) on June 23, 2015. This direct final rule is effective September 8, 2015, unless significant adverse comments are received by July 23, 2015.

The direct final rule amended the NRC's spent fuel storage regulations by revising the NAC International, Inc., MAGNASTOR® System listing within the "list of approved spent fuel storage casks" to include Amendment No. 5 to Certificate of Compliance No. 1031.
