Credit Monitoring Services

On August 13, 2015, as a result of a non-competitive solicitation, cost-reimbursement Interagency Agreement NRC-HQ-7N-15-I-0002 was awarded to the Office of Personnel Management in Washington, D.C. The objective of this agreement is to provide credit monitoring services for federal employees that were affected by the recent cyber security breach. The period of performance is August 13, 2015, through September 30, 2016. The total cost ceiling is \$260,000.

<u>Technical and Rulemaking Support of Part 26 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal</u> *Regulations* Fitness for Duty Programs

On August 13, 2015, as a result of a non-competitive solicitation, cost-reimbursement task order NRC-HQ-11-15-T-0001 was issued under enterprise-wide contract NRC-HQ-25-14-E-0004 to Numark Associates, Inc. in Washington, DC. The objective of this task order is to obtain technical expertise to assist the NRC staff in conducting technical evaluations and rulemaking activities in support of Fitness for Duty programs. The period of performance is September 1, 2015, through October 31, 2017. The total cost ceiling is \$603,932.

Revisions to Transportation Safety Requirements and Harmonization with International Atomic Energy Agency Transportation Requirements; Corrections; Final Rule; Correcting Amendments; 10 CFR Part 71 (RIN 3150-Al11; NRC-2008-0198)

On August 14, 2015, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 48683) that corrected a final rule published in the *Federal Register* on June 12, 2015 (80 FR 33988). The final rule, in consultation with the U.S. Department of Transportation, amended the NRC's regulations for the packaging and transportation of radioactive material. The final rule contained minor editorial errors in a calculation, outdated contact information, and outdated information for examining the materials that are incorporated by reference. This document corrected the final rule by revising the definition that contains these errors, and updated the contact and examination information. This final rule was effective on August 14, 2015.

<u>Abnormal Occurrence Reports; Proposed Revision to Policy Statement; Request for Comments; 10 CFR Part 1 (NRC-2015-0176)</u>

On August 17, 2015, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 49177) proposing revisions to its policy statement on reporting Abnormal Occurrences (AO) to Congress. The proposed revisions would clarify and restructure the criteria used by the NRC and Agreement States for determining whether to consider an incident or event as an AO. The proposed revisions to the policy statement would ensure consistency with current NRC guidance and regulations. Public comments are due by November 16, 2015.

<u>List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks: Holtec International HI-STORM 100 Cask System, Certificate of Compliance No. 1014, Amendment No. 8, Revision 1; Final Rule; 10 CFR Part 72 (Regulation Identifier Number (RIN) 3150-AJ47; NRC-2014-0233)</u>

On August 18, 2015, the NRC published a final rule in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 49887) amending its spent fuel storage regulations by revising the Holtec International HI-STORM 100 Cask System listing within the "List of approved spent fuel storage casks," to add Revision 1 to

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Amendment No. 8 (effective May 2, 2012, as corrected on November 16, 2012), to the Certificate of Compliance No. 1014. Amendment No. 8, Revision 1, changes burnup/cooling time limits for thimble plug devices, changes Metamic-HT material testing requirements, changes Metamic-HT material minimum guaranteed values, and updates fuel definitions to allow boiling water reactor fuel affected by certain corrosion mechanisms with specific guidelines to be classified as undamaged fuel. This final rule is effective February 16, 2016.
