Technical Support for Human Factors Engineering (HFE) Guidance Development

On August 20, 2015, as a result of a non-competitive solicitation, cost-reimbursement task order number NRC-60-15-T-0021 was issued under interagency agreement NRC-HQ-25-14-D-0002 to Brookhaven National Laboratory (BNL) in Upton, New York. The objective of this task order is to obtain technical expertise from BNL to assist NRC staff in the HFE guidance development process, using the Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research's four-step methodology. The period of performance is August 20, 2015, through February 15, 2020. The total estimated cost ceiling is \$1,858,791.

Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel's Hearing Room Audio-Visual Refresh

On August 27, 2015, as the result of a non-competitive solicitation, labor-hour task order number NRC-HQ-7D-15-T-0001 was issued under contract NRC-HQ-7D-14-C-0002 to Dynamic Systems Integration, Inc. of Virginia Beach, Virginia. The objective of this task order is to provide maintenance support services and modifications/updates to the Hearing Room Audio and Video Equipment System. The period of performance is August 27, 2015, through August 20, 2016. The total estimated cost ceiling is \$377,800.

Information Technology (IT) Solutions - Integrated Program and Project Support

On August 27, 2015, as a result of a non-competitive solicitation, order number NRC-HQ-10-15-O-0001 was issued under blanket purchase agreement NRC-HQ-10-15-A-0002 to Northramp, LLC, in Reston, Virginia. The objective of this order is to provide core information technology (IT) and information management services related to policy, planning, information security, investment management, enterprise and IT architecture, and program and project management to NRC's Office of Information Services. The period of performance is August 27, 2015, through May 27, 2020, and the estimated cost ceiling is \$10,562,662, inclusive of all options.

<u>Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal: Proposed Rule and Draft NUREG; Reopening of Comment Period; Parts 20 and 61 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR);</u> (Regulation Identifier Number 3150-Al92; NRC-2011-0012 and NRC-2015-0003)

On August 27, 2015, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 51964) that reopened the comment period on a proposed rule (80 FR 16081; March 26, 2015) that would amend its regulations that govern low-level radioactive waste disposal facilities, and on draft guidance to address implementation of the proposed regulation, NUREG-2175, "Guidance for Conducting Technical Analyses for 10 CFR Part 61" (80 FR 15930; March 26, 2015). The public comment period for the proposed rule and draft guidance closed on July 24, 2015. The NRC is reopening the public comment period for the proposed rule and draft guidance to allow more time for members of the public to develop and submit their comments. Comments should be filed no later than September 21, 2015.

Rescinding Spent Fuel Pool Exclusion Regulations: Petition for Rulemaking (PRM); Denial; 10 CFR Part 51 (Docket Nos. PRM-51-29, NRC-2012-0215)

On September 3, 2015, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 53266) denying PRM-51-29, submitted by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts (the petitioner). The petitioner requested that, in light of information gained from the Fukushima Dai-ichi accident, the

NRC rescind its regulations that make a generic determination that spent fuel pool storage does not have a significant environmental impact for nuclear power plant license renewal actions. The NRC is denying the petition because the NRC finds no basis to consider a rulemaking to revise such regulations. The docket for PRM-51-29 was closed on September 3, 2015.
