### Operations and Maintenance of NRC Security System

On September 30, 2015, as a result of a non-competitive solicitation, cost reimbursement task order NRC-HQ-40-15-T-0001 was issued under enterprise-wide contract NRC-HQ-40-15-E-0006 to Signet Technologies, Inc. in Beltsville, Maryland. The objective of this task order is to perform operations and maintenance of the existing security system related to the protection of NRC personnel, facilities, and information. The period of performance is September 30, 2015, through March 30, 2016. The total cost ceiling is \$252,340.

Revisions to the Petition for Rulemaking Process: Final Rule; Part 2 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (Regulation Identifier Number 3150-Al30; NRC-2009-0044)

On October 7, 2015, the NRC published a final rule in the Federal Register (80 FR 60513) amending its regulations to clarify and streamline its process for addressing petitions for rulemaking. The amendments are intended to improve transparency and to make the petition for rulemaking process more efficient and effective. The final rule is effective on November 6, 2015.

# <u>Fire Human Reliability Analysis and Fire Probabilistic Risk Assessment (PRA) Training Course</u>

From September 28-October 2, 2015, staff from RES and the Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI) conducted a training course on Fire Human Reliability Analysis and Fire Probabilistic Risk Assessment. These were the final two sessions of a 5-part series, which provided training in subject areas related to Fire PRA, including: Fire Analysis (July 20-24), Advanced Fire Modeling (August 17-24), and Electrical Analysis (August 24-28). The purpose of the course is to provide detailed, hands-on training on the fire PRA methodology described in NUREG/CR-6850, "EPRI/NRC-RES Fire PRA Methodology for Nuclear Power Facilities." The workshop was attended by approximately 100 participants, including: NRC employees; licensees and consultants; participants from other government agencies; and a number of representatives from foreign regulators and licensees.

#### Meeting of the Interagency Committee on Standards Policy (ICSP)

On September 30, 2015, RES staff participated in a meeting of the Interagency Committee on Standards Policy (ICSP), composed of the standards executives from Executive branch agencies. The ICSP meets 2-3 times per year, including its annual joint meeting with the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) Government Members Forum (GMF) during ANSI's World Standards Week. Attendees heard updates on international trade negotiations, conformity assessment, and efforts to have consensus standards published in a format that can be used by automated documentation systems. Other updates included environmental purchasing guidelines and developments in cybersecurity and forensics standards. Updated Government-wide guidance on the use of consensus standards (OMB Circular A-119) is expected to be issued about one month from the meeting.
