- Title: Improved Identification Techniques against Alkali-Silica Reaction (ASR) Concrete Degradation at Nuclear Power Plants [NRC-2014-0257]
- Description of the petition for rulemaking (PRM): This *Federal Register* notice denies PRM-50-109, which requested that the NRC amend its regulations to provide improved identification techniques for better protection against concrete degradation due to ASR at U.S. nuclear power plants by requiring all licensees to comply with American Concrete Institute Committee Report ACI 349.3R, "Evaluation of Existing Nuclear Safety-Related Concrete Structures," and American Society for Testing and Materials Standard C856-11, "Standard Practice for Petrographic Examination of Hardened Concrete."
- Dates: The docket for the petition for rulemaking PRM-50-109 will be closed on the date of publication.
