The Commission (with Commissioner Baran dissenting) approved a Memorandum and Order responding to the City of Miami's appeal of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision in LBP-15-19, which denied the City's petition to intervene as a party in the combined license proceeding for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7. The Memorandum and Order denies review without prejudice.
