## I. <u>SECY-15-0145 – NEXTERA ENERGY SEABROOK, LLC (SEABROOK STATION, UNIT 1): MOTION TO WITHDRAW FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT</u>

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding Order responding to a motion by Friends of the Coast and New England Coalition requesting the withdrawal, and re-issuance for public comment, of the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement prepared for the Seabrook Station, Unit 1 license renewal application. The Memorandum and Order denies the motion.

## II. SECY-16-0008 – SHINE MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIES, INC. (MEDICAL RADIOISOTOPE PRODUCTION FACILITY). MANDATORY HEARING DECISION
