I. <u>SECY-15-0013 / SECY-15-0013B – Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Dresden Nuclear Power Station)—Notice of Appeal of LBP-14-4</u>

The Commission (with Commissioner Baran dissenting) approved a Memorandum and Order addressing the appeal of Local 15, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, AFL-CIO, of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision in LBP-14-4 denying Local 15's request for hearing on Confirmatory Order EA-13-068. The Memorandum and Order dismisses Local 15's appeal as moot and terminates the proceeding.

II. <u>SECY-15-0171 – Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (Indian Point Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 2)—Appeal of LBP-15-26</u>

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to the State of New York's appeal of LBP-15-26, in which the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board denied New York's intervention petition associated with a license amendment request to decrease the frequency of containment integrated leak rate tests at Indian Point, Unit 2. The Memorandum and Order affirms the Board's decision in LBP-15-26.
