<u>Fuel-Cladding Issues in Postulated Spent Fuel Pool Accidents: Petition for Rulemaking (PRM); Denial; Part 50 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) (PRM-50-108; NRC-2014-0171)</u>

On May 13, 2016, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (81 FR 29761) denying PRM-50-108 submitted by Mr. Mark Edward Leyse (the petitioner). The petitioner requested that the NRC require power reactor licensees to perform evaluations to determine the potential consequences of various postulated spent fuel pool accident scenarios and to submit the evaluations to the NRC for informational purposes. The docket for the petition was closed on May 13, 2016.

Generic Determinations Regarding the Environmental Impacts of Spent Fuel Storage and Disposal when Considering Nuclear Power Reactor License Applications: PRM; Denial; 10 CFR Part 51 (PRM-51-30 and PRM-51-31; NRC-2014-0014 and NRC-2014-0055)

On May 19, 2016, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (81 FR 31532) denying PRM-51-30 and PRM-51-31 submitted by Diane Curran on behalf of 34 environmental organizations (the petitioners). The petitioners requested that the NRC revise certain regulations that concern the environmental impacts of spent fuel storage and disposal for nuclear power plant license applications. The dockets for the petitions were closed on May 19, 2016.
