The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order addressing the State of Vermont's appeal of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's denial of its hearing request and Vermont's petition for reconsideration of the Commission's decision on a request for exemptions from the NRC's emergency planning requirements. The Commission, with Commissioner Svinicki providing additional views and Commissioner Baran concurring in part and dissenting in part, has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order that affirms the Board's decision in Licensing Board Panel 15-18 and terminates the proceeding. The Commission also considered Vermont's petition for reconsideration of the exemptions and sustained the Commission's decision in the Staff Requirements Memorandum for SECY-14-0125.
