Subject: Certification of Permanent Cessation of Power Operations

On June 16, 2016, Omaha Public Power District's (OPPPO) Board of Directors voted to permanently cease operations of Fort Calhoun Station (FCS) by December 31, 2016, due to financial reasons.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.82(a)(1)(i), OPPPO certifies to the NRC that it plans to permanently cease power operations at Fort Calhoun Station by December 31, 2016. A more specific date cannot be provided at this time in order to allow for fuel coastdown variables. OPPPO will submit a supplement to this letter certifying the cessation date in accordance with 10 CFR 50.82(a)(1)(i) and 10 CFR 50.4(b)(8).
