Staff Issued Fermi 2 Safety Evaluation Report Related to the License Renewal

On July 15, 2016, the staff issued the Fermi 2 Nuclear Power Plant (Fermi 2) Safety Evaluation Report (SER) related to the license renewal in preparation for the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards Full Committee meeting scheduled for September 8, 2016. The staff reviewed the license renewal application (LRA) for Fermi 2 in accordance with NRC regulations and NUREG-1800, Revision 2, "Standard Review Plan for Review of License Renewal Applications for Nuclear Power Plants," dated December 2010. On the basis of its review of the LRA, the staff has determined that the requirements of 10 CFR 54.29(a) have been met.

**SPLUNK Enterprise Licenses and Support**

On July 14, 2016, contract number NRC-HQ-10-16-C-0001 was awarded to Spear Incorporated, in Herndon, Virginia. The purpose of this contract is to provide SPLUNK License and maintenance support. SPLUNK collects, analyzes and monitors data generated from NRC's infrastructure, security systems and business applications. The period of performance is from July 15, 2016 through July 14, 2018, with three option years. The total potential value over the life of the contract is \$583,507.00.

**Variable Annual Fee Structure for Small Modular Reactors; Corrections: Correcting Amendments; Part 171 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) (Regulation Identifier Number (RIN) 3150-AI54; NRC-2008-0664)**

On July 15, 2016, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* ([81 FR 45963](#)) that corrected a grammatical error in a definition, an incorrect reference format, and an incomplete signature date in a final rule published in the *Federal Register* on May 24, 2016 ([81 FR 32617](#)). The final rule amended the NRC's licensing, inspection, and annual fee regulations to establish a variable annual fee structure for light-water small modular reactors. This document corrects the final rule by revising the sections that contain these errors and completing the signature date. This correction was effective on July 15, 2016.
