Enclosed is the After Action Report/Improvement Plan for the Beaver Valley Power Station (BVPS) Plume Exercise for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that was held on June 14, 2016.

There were no Level 1 Findings, Level 2 Findings, or Planning Issues identified during the exercise. Two prior Planning Issues were corrected and closed prior to the exercise.
