## I. <u>SECY-16-0099 – U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY (EXPORT OF 93.20% ENRICHED</u> <u>URANIUM) (PETITION SEEKING LEAVE TO INTERVENE AND REQUEST FOR</u> <u>HEARING)</u>

This matter involves the application of the U.S. Department of Energy, National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) to export up to 130 kilograms of highly enriched uranium to France's CERCA facility and the Institut Laue-Langevin. The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to a request for hearing and petition to intervene filed by Dr. Alan J. Kuperman on this export license application. The Memorandum and Order denies Dr. Kuperman's hearing request and directs the Office of International Programs to issue the export license.

(Subsequently, on October 5, 2016, the Secretary signed the Memorandum and Order.)
