I. <u>SECY-16-0119 – FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT CO. (TURKEY POINT NUCLEAR</u> <u>GENERATING UNITS 3 AND 4), INTERVENOR'S APPEAL OF LBP-16-8</u>

The Commission, with Commissioner Baran dissenting, approved a Memorandum and Order addressing the petition for review of Citizens Allied for Safe Energy (CASE) on the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's ruling on the merits of Contention 1 in this license amendment matter. The Memorandum and Order denies CASE's petition for review.

## II. <u>SECY-16-0130 – DUKE ENERGY CAROLINAS, LLC (WILLIAM STATES LEE III</u> <u>NUCLEAR STATION, UNITS 1 AND 2) MANDATORY HEARING DECISION</u>

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order addressing the required findings of 10 C.F.R. §§ 52.97(a) and 51.107(a) and the issues discussed at the uncontested hearing on October 5, 2016, concerning the application of Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC to construct and operate two AP1000 reactors at the William States Lee III Nuclear Station site in Cherokee County, South Carolina. The Memorandum and Order authorizes issuance of the combined licenses and approves the location of the Lee Emergency Operations Facility.
