I. <u>SECY-16-0143 – FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT CO. (TURKEY POINT NUCLEAR</u> <u>GENERATING UNITS 6 AND 7), POSTPONEMENT OF MANDATORY HEARING</u>

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order addressing the schedule for the mandatory hearing associated with the combined license application for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7. The Memorandum and Order postpones the mandatory hearing until the NRC Staff has completed ongoing consultations required by the Endangered Species Act. The Commission directs the Staff to provide within ten days its best estimate of the time frame for concluding consultations and to supplement its testimony in this matter once consultations have concluded.
