# Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research (RES) Items of Interest Week Ending February 10, 2017

### Meeting with Representatives of the American Institute in Taiwan, the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission

On February 7, 2017, representatives from RES and the Office of International Programs (OIP) met with representatives from the American Institute in Taiwan and the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office in the United States (AIT-TECRO) to exchange information on a variety of probabilistic risk assessment (PRA) topics of mutual interest. Discussions focused on the status of risk-informed PRA applications in Taiwan, the Commission-directed full-scope, site Level 3 PRA study for the Vogtle Electric Generating Plant (SRM SECY 11-0089), and general PRA issues including human reliability analysis, data analysis, system success criteria, station blackout modeling, and severe accident modeling. The representatives from AIT-TECRO expressed appreciation for the meeting and a desire to continue PRA-related technical information exchange meetings in the future.
