<u>Staff Participation in 2nd International Review Panel Meeting with ENSI Regarding</u> Cracking Detected at Beznau Reactor

During the week of January 23, 2017, staff attended the final meeting of an international review panel (IRP), hosted by the Swiss Regulator (ENSI) concerning documents submitted by Beznau nuclear power plant (NPP) regarding cracking detected at the reactor. The IRP's continued evaluation of the documents revealed no unexpected information. The IRP report, expected to be completed at the end of February, is one of the many inputs ENSI will factor into its decision on whether to restart Beznau NPP. A timeframe has not been established for this decision.
