The Commission was briefed by an external panel and a panel of NRC staff on the status of actions taken in response to lessons learned from the Fukushima Dai-ichi accident. Topics included; industry progress, site implementation, State perspectives on Group 3 Recommendation 11.3 – real-time radiation monitoring, NGO perspectives on NRC's and industry's implementation of the Fukushima lessons-learned, status of Tier 1 implementation, overview of staff's final assessment of Group 3 Recommendations, and the Mitigation of Beyond Design Basis Events Rulemaking. The external panelists were Joseph E. Pollock, Vice President of Operations and Chief Nuclear Officer, Nuclear Energy Institute; Bill Pitesa, Senior Vice President and Chief Nuclear Officer, Duke Energy Corporation; Patrick Mulligan, Chief, Bureau of Nuclear Engineering, Division of Energy Security and Sustainability, New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and David Lochbaum, Director, Nuclear Safety Project, Union of Concerned Scientists.
