CHAIRMAN SVINICKI: Madam Secretary, I believe we have one item for affirmation. Would you please lead us through? Thank you.

ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: This is SECY-17-0021 – Susquehanna Nuclear, LLC (Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2). The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order responding to a request by Mr. Sabatini Monatesti for a hearing on the application of Susquehanna Nuclear, LLC, for an indirect transfer of control of its interests in the operating licenses for the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2, and in the general license for the station's Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation. Mr. Monatesti also requested access to sensitive, unclassified, non-safeguards information (SUNSI) withheld from the publicly available record. The NRC staff denied Mr. Monatesti's request for access to the SUNSI, and in Licensing Board Panel-16-12 an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board affirmed the staff's decision. Mr. Monatesti appealed the Board's decision.

The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order that affirms the Board's decision and denies Mr. Monatesti's request for a hearing.
