### Electric Power Research Institute Advanced Reactor Technical Advisory Group Meeting

On March 21, 2017, staff from the Office of New Reactors and RES attended the Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI) Advanced Reactor Technical Advisory Group Meeting in Charlotte, NC. Participants included representatives from EPRI, the Department of Energy (DOE), utilities, reactor design companies, Canada, and France. Presentations included overviews of EPRI's lead projects (owner-operator requirements document for advanced reactors, probabilistic risk assessment best practices, materials gap analysis, advanced manufacturing), DOE's Gateway for Accelerated Innovation in Nuclear initiative, and Nuclear Energy Institute's advanced reactor initiatives. Also, Electricite de France provided an overview of the operating experience with the Phenix and Superphenix Liquid Sodium Fast Reactors.
