The State of Indiana has requested Federal participation at the Indiana Ingestion Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) exercise held in conjunction with the D.C. Cook Plume Exercise scheduled for the week of June 3-7, 2019. The REP exercise will be both a plume phase and ingestion pathway exercise with full participation from the State of Indiana Emergency Operations Center and the Indiana Department of Health Radiochemistry Lab, and the Counties of Elkhart, Jasper, Kosciusko, LaGrange, Lake, LaPorte, Marshall, Porter, St. Joseph, and Starke. There are secondary counties in northern Indiana that may participate on a partial basis.

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission-RIII is requested to provide a Federal Advisory Team member to participate with Indiana on June 4-5, 2019.
