List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks: TN Americas LLC, NUHOMS® EOS Dry Spent Fuel Storage System, Certificate of Compliance No. 1042; Direct Final Rule; Part 72 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) (Regulation Identifier Number (RIN) 3150-AJ88; NRC-2016-0254)

On March 24, 2017, the NRC published a direct final rule in the *Federal Register* (82 FR 14987) amending its spent fuel storage regulations by adding the TN Americas LLC, NUHOMS® Extended Optimized Storage (EOS) Dry Spent Fuel Storage System, to the "List of approved spent fuel storage casks" as Certificate of Compliance No. 1042. The NUHOMS® EOS System provides horizontal storage of high burnup spent pressurized water reactor and boiling water reactor fuel assemblies in dry shielded canisters. The companion proposed rule was also published in the *Federal Register* on March 24, 2017 (82 FR 15007). Unless significant adverse comments are received, the direct final rule will become effective June 7, 2017.

### Non-Power Production or Utilization Facility License Renewal; Proposed Rule; 10 CFR Parts 2, 50, and 51 (RIN 3150-Al96; NRC-2011-0087)

On March 30, 2017, the NRC published a proposed rule in the *Federal Register* (82 FR 15643) proposing to amend its regulations that govern the license renewal process for non-power reactors, testing facilities, and other production or utilization facilities, licensed under the authority of Section 103, Section 104a, or Section 104c of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, that are not nuclear power reactors. Comments are due by June 13, 2017.

## Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research Publication of Draft Regulatory Guide DG-1326 – "Quality Assurance Program Criteria (Design and Construction)"

The staff released draft Regulatory Guide DG-1326 – "Quality Assurance Program Criteria (Design and Construction)," for public comment. DG-1326 is proposed Revision 5 to Regularity Guide (RG) 1.28. The RG is being revised to update the guidance to endorse, with clarification or exceptions, multiple revisions of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) standard NQA-1, "Quality Assurance Requirements for Nuclear Facility Applications." This Draft Regulatory Guide (DG) was developed by the Office of New Reactors in coordination with RES. The DG is publically available in ADAMS at Accession No. ML16180A264. A notice announcing the availability of DG-1326 for comment was published in the *Federal Register* on March 27, 2017.
