The NRC staff recommends approval of Duke Energy's request to consolidate the emergency operations facilities (EOFs) for the Brunswick, Shearon Harris, and Robinson plants into Duke's existing EOF in Charlotte, which currently serves as the EOF for four other nuclear power plants operated by Duke (Catawba, McGuire, Oconee, and, if constructed, Lee). In its analysis of Duke's request, the staff examined several factors, including the technical and communications capabilities of the facility, its capacity to address a multi-site event, the experience and anticipated training of the personnel available at Duke's Charlotte corporate headquarters to staff the EOF, and the familiarity of NRC, state, and local emergency response personnel with the facility. Based on its analysis, the NRC staff concluded that the consolidated EOF "will continue to effectively support Duke Energy's emergency response at all of the sites that the facility serves" and that "protective measures can and will be implemented in the event of a radiological emergency at any of the sites that the facility serves." In addition, the North Carolina and South Carolina state and local agencies with emergency response roles have indicated their concurrence with the proposed consolidation. For these reasons, I approve Duke Energy's proposal to consolidate the three additional site EOFs into Duke's existing Charlotte EOF.
