### <u>Columbia Generating Station - Approval of Measurement Uncertainty Recapture (MUR)</u> <u>Power Uprate</u>

On May 11, 2017, the staff approved a 1.7 percent MUR power uprate for the Columbia Generating Station. The MUR power uprate approved a generating capacity increase from approximately 1190 MWe to 1210 MWe. Energy Northwest plans to implement the MUR power uprate this summer.
