ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: This is on SECY-17-0053 – Entergy Nuclear Operations, LLC & Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. James A. Fitzpatrick Nuclear Power Plant. The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order responding to Beyond Nuclear and The Alliance for a Green Economy's request for a hearing and petition to intervene on requests submitted by Entergy Nuclear FitzPatrick, LLC and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. for relaxation of three Nuclear Regulatory Commission post-Fukushima orders at the James A. FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant. These orders address mitigation strategies for beyond-design-basis events, reliable spent fuel pool instrumentation, and installation of reliable hardened containment vents. The petitioners contend that Entergy's requests are actually license amendment applications with accompanying hearing rights.

The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and order that denies the hearing request.
