<u>List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks: EnergySolutions[™] Corporation, VSC-24</u> <u>Ventilated Storage Cask System, Renewal of Initial Certificate and Amendment</u> <u>Nos. 1-6, Direct Final Rule; Part 72 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations</u> (Regulation Identifier Number 3150-AJ78; NRC-2016-0138)

On July 7, 2017, the NRC published a direct final rule in the *Federal Register* (82 FR 31433) amending its spent fuel storage regulations by revising the EnergySolutions[™] Corporation's VSC-24 Ventilated Storage Cask System listing within the "List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks," to renew for an additional 40 years, the initial certificate and Amendment Nos. 1-6 of Certificate of Compliance No. 1007. The renewal of the initial certificate and Amendment Nos. 1-6 of Certificate cask users to establish, implement, and maintain written procedures for aging management program elements. The companion proposed rule was also published in the *Federal Register* on July 7, 2017 (82 FR 31512). Unless significant adverse comments are received, the direct final rule will become effective on August 7, 2017.

Integrated University Program Grants

On June 30, 2017, the Office of Administration, Acquisition Management Division, awarded grants to 35 universities in support of the NRC's Integrated University Program. The objective of the program is to provide opportunities to qualified individuals and academic institutions by funding undergraduate scholarships, graduate fellowships, trade school scholarships, and faculty development grants in nuclear education and nuclear related fields. The period of performance for these grants ranges from 2-4 years. The potential value for this grant program, as funded by fiscal year 2017 resources, is \$14,999,547.
