ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: This is the final rule on Modified Small Quantities Protocol

The Commission is being asked to act on a final rule amending Part 75 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

This final rule makes amendments to the NRC's regulations that are necessary for the United States to implement "The Agreement Between the United States of America and the International Atomic Energy Agency for the Application of Safeguards in Connection with the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America" that applies to the U.S. Caribbean Territories pursuant to modifications to this Agreement's Small Quantities Protocol, including allowing for the collection of information on source and special nuclear material in the United States Caribbean Territories and allowing for IAEA inspection access.

The Commission has voted to approve the publication and implementation of this final rule subject to the changes noted in the attachment. Additionally, the Commission has certified, under the Regulatory Flexibility Act that this rule will not have significant economic impact on a substantial number of small entities.
