NRC Reschedules Public Meeting to Discuss Westinghouse Fuel Facility License Renewal

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has rescheduled a public meeting for Nov. 8 to discuss its licensing and oversight activities, license renewal and the associated environmental review, and recent leaks at the Westinghouse Columbia nuclear fuel fabrication facility. The meeting was originally scheduled for Oct. 11, but was postponed due to forecasts of inclement weather from Tropical Storm Michael.

The meeting will be held from 7-9 p.m. at The Medallion Conference Center, 7309 Garners Ferry Road, in Columbia, S.C., with an open house 30 minutes prior to the meeting for informal discussion.

During the meeting, NRC staff will explain the agency's role and responsibilities related to licensing and oversight programs at the Westinghouse Columbia nuclear fuel fabrication facility. The NRC staff will discuss the license renewal process, including the environmental review, which staff reopened after being informed of relevant new information. The NRC staff will also provide information regarding the NRC's response to the leaks at the facility.
