
Rulemaking at the NRC


- The responsibility for leading, managing, and facilitating rulemaking activities is with the Division of Rulemaking within the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards

Abstract:	This rulemaking would amend the NRC's regulations to update and clarify the license renewal process for non-power production or utilization facilities (NPUFs). The rule would eliminate license renewal for NPUFs for use in medical therapy, and define the license renewal process for commercial and industrial NPUFs. This rulemaking would reduce the resources needed for longer-term licensing of NPUFs.
