On October 19, 2018, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security inspection at your Donald C. Cook Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 and 2. On December 18, 2018, the NRC inspectors discussed the results of this inspection with you and other members of your staff. The results of this inspection are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

The NRC inspectors did not identify any finding or violation of more-than-minor significance.

However, the inspectors documented one licensee-identified violation, which was determined to be of very-low security significance in this report. The NRC is treating this violation as a Non-Cited Violation consistent with Section 2.3.2.a of the Enforcement Policy.

If you contest the violation or significance of the Non-Cited Violation, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region III; the Director, Office of Enforcement; the Director, Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response; and the NRC Resident inspector at the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Power Plant.
