
Dear Mr. Matthews:

In response to your letter dated May 30, 1989 that states your concerns, in regard to the above subject matter, I have decided to provide additional protection for the ASW piping by

- 1) Vitalizing the West Penetration Rooms - Units 1, 2 and 3
- 2) Vitalizing the Decon Tank Rooms - Units 1, 2 and 3
- 3) Vitalizing the Section of ASW Piping in the yard - Units 1, 2 and 3.

The above measures will enhance the protection of the SSS ASW to meet the concerns raised by the Oconee Regulatory Effectiveness Review in September of 1985. The compensatory measures currently employed will remain in effect until the modifications are completed.
