Gentlemen:

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54 (p)(2), Georgia Power Company submits a change to the Physical Security Plan for the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant. The enclosed revision reflects implementation of the NRC's Final Rule, "Access Control of Personnel and Materials at Primary Containment," published in the Federal Register September 7, 1995. The change deletes the requirement for licensees to station security personnel at the primary containment during periods of high traffic.

Georgia Power Company has determined the enclosed change does not decrease the effectiveness of the Physical Security Plan and follows the NRC staff's position that implementation of the rule change through the 10 CFR 50.54 (p)(2) process is acceptable. Therefore, a justification for the determination of no decrease in safeguards effectiveness is not provided. The enclosure contains revision insertion instructions and the revised Physical Security Plan pages.

The information contained in the enclosure is categorized as Safeguards Information, and in accordance with 10 CFR 73.21, this document should be withheld from public disclosure.


