This letter is to certify, pursuant to the requirements of 10 CFR 26.73(d), that Wisconsin Electric Power Company, licensee for the Point Beach Nuclear Plant Units 1 and 2, has implemented a Fitness-For-Duty program which meets the requirements of 10 CFR Part 26 for all personnel having unescolted access to the Point Beach Nuclear Plant protected areas, which includes the TSC, or Emergency Operations Facility. The program does not use any testing cut-off levels which are more stringent than those imposed by Part 26.

Periodic mandatory random chemical testing under this program will commence on January 3, 1990, under the conditions prescribed in the Fitness-For-Duty program. Any questions concerning our program should be directed to Mr. Dennis Lawler, Vice President - Human Resources.
