ADDRESS ISSUES OUTLINED IN COMMISSION  
ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES  
FOR DECISION ON ENFORCEMENT ACTION,  
CLI-83-11, May 5, 1983

In its order of May 5, 1983, the Commission has invited the licensees and interested federal agencies and State and local governments to address the Commission on the FEMA report and on the subject of shutdown. Sl. op. at 3.

The Commission did not invite Parents Concerned About Indian Point to supply their views to the Commission. Nor were any of the other Intervenor in the current hearing invited to participate on May 26. Parents has spent several years studying the status of emergency planning at Indian Point, and has presented much testimony thereon, in addition to cross-examining other witnesses on this area. In addition, Parents is entitled to participate on May 26 as a matter of legal right, since the Commission will be considering the same


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issues as are currently before the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board.

Parents Concerned About Indian Point therefore moves that it, and the other Intervenors, be given the opportunity, along with the Licensees and governmental entities, to present written and oral views according to the schedule established by the Commission Order of May 5, 1983.
