DIESEL GENERATOR FUEL OIL SUPPLY
POINT BEACH NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

Enclosed is Licensee Event Report 90-003-00 for Point Beach Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. This report is being provided in accordance with 10 CFR 50.73 (a)(2)(v), "The licensee shall report...any event or condition that alone could have prevented the fulfillment of the safety function of structures or systems..."

This report describes the condition that existed when it was determined that a portion of the fuel oil piping between the emergency fuel oil tank and the emergency diesel generator fuel oil day tanks was not seismically supported. Therefore we could not prove extended operability of our diesel generators due to the potential for a seismic induced failure of the fuel oil line from the onsite storage tanks to the diesels. This condition was the subject of a requested Temporary Waiver of Compliance documented in our letter, NRC 90-136, dated April 10, 1990.
