ONE-TIME EXTENSION OF DIESEL GENERATOR SURVEILLANCE INTERVAL

Gentlemen:

On April 19, 1990, Carolina Power & Light Company requested a change to the Technical Specifications for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit 1. The proposed change revises the surveillance interval associated with Technical Specification 4.8.1.1.2.d.1 to allow a one-time only extension of the surveillance requirement until October 31, 1990. This extension allows operation of Brunswick-1 until the upcoming Reload 7 outage currently scheduled to begin in September 1990. Enclosure 1 provides the typed Technical Specification page for your convenience in issuance of the proposed request.
