An Application for Amendment to the above operating licenses to revise the Electrical Power System Shutdown, the A.C. Distribution - Shutdown, and the D.C. Distribution - Shutdown Specifications to more closely resemble the wording contained in the Standard Technical Specifications. This proposed change includes the addition of the requirement that an operable 120 volt A.C. Vital Bus must be energized from an connected to a D.C. Bus.
