Entergy Operations, Inc. submitted by letter dated August 31, 1988 (AECM-88/0177) and March 24, 1989 (AECM-89/0058), a proposed amendment to the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS) Operating License along with supplemental information to support the amendment request. The proposed amendment would delete certain test, vent and drain (TVD) valves from Technical Specification Table 3.6.4-1. The Technical Specification testing requirements for TVD valves would be replaced with an administrative leakage control program which would ensure the leak tight integrity of these TVD valves.

It is currently our understanding that the containment isolation valve listing of Table 3.6.4-1 will be relocated from the Technical Specifications as part of the Technical Specifications Improvement Program (TSIP). Since GGNS is a lead plant participant in the TSIP, Entergy Operations is willing to forgo the immediate relief sought after in the proposed amendment request.

Therefore, by this letter, Entergy Operations hereby withdraws the proposed amendment request submitted in AECM-88/0177 as supplemented by AECM-89/0058.
